The Annual charges:

• There is no waiver of annual fee in a bad credit credit card against the popular annual fee waiver in normal credit cards. There can be an annual fee from a minimum of \$20 to \$150 depending upon your APR and the type of bad credit credit card you have taken or are going to qualify for. Compare the annual fee of all the bad credit credit card options laid down before you.

Processing charges:

• The processing fee is mostly a one time charge as a mean to issue you with the card initially. Some premier services do not levy this charge. The processing fee is not a recurring one. However, if you happen to get other total limit of purchases to EMI you may incur the EMI processing fee and not the card issuance processing fee.

High levels of interest:

• Most bad credit credit cards come with a high rate of interest. Be assured that you are not paralyzed to pay high interest. So, make judicious use of your card to prevent relapsing on bad scores over again.

Other Charges:

• Some companies require you to pay upfront money to issue you with the card never pay it. You can always discard or refuse this card necessity once you establish your credit rating and go for other cards!
